DECISION AND JUDGMENT

This matter came before the Civil Service Commission ("Commission") for a Motion to Reconsider on Tuesday, February 20, 2024. Present for the Commission was Chairman Juan K. Calvo, Vice Chairman Anthony P. Benavente, Commissioner Robert C. Taitano, and Commissioner Francisco T. Guerrero.

Present for Management of the Guam Fire Department ("GFD") was Joey San Nicolas, GFD Deputy Fire Chief/Acting Fire Chief. John-Anthony Blas Muna, Employee, was present with his Attorney, Christian Spotanski of the Razzano Walsh & Torres P.C.

This Post Audit case was filed with the Commission by the Employee on April 07, 2023. On November 28, 2023, a Board Hearing was conduced and it was determined that the Commission was fifty-five (55) days passed their authority, as such, the case would be

dismissed for lack of jurisdiction. The decision was signed off at a Board Hearing held on December 05, 2023. The Commission heard from the Parties on the request for reconsideration. The Commission discussed the issue and deliberated.

The Commission voted one (1) to three (3) on the reconsideration with three votes in favor of Management and failing to garner an affirmative vote of four (4), the Employee's Motion for Reconsideration failed. The Commission dismissed the Employee's Post Audit Complaint.
