Complainant applied to be promoted to Fire Service Specialist position, but was not selected. Complainant advises that he should have gotten the promotion. Complainant states that his score/rating sheet was manipulated after his interview.

After a thorough investigation, Staff found that Department of Administration did not follow the approved certification procedure pursuant to the Department of Administration's Personnel Rules and Regulations, Rule 4.410 to 4.413.

By a vote of 4 to 0 the Commission voted to provisionally null and void all the Fire Service Specialists (FSS) promotions.

Upon receipt of the signed Order After Hearing, Management has ten (10) days to respond to the Commission's decision to provisionally null and void the personnel actions pursuant to 4 GCA, § 4403(d).
